

Guaranteed Admissions



Olympia School District has partnered with the [Guaranteed Admissions Pilot \(GAP\) Program](#), Pacific Lutheran University, and St. Martin's University to support the college and career goals of all students. Many of Washington's public and private institutions have a focus on increasing access and credential completion in the state.

These participating institutions require only two criteria to be met for a student to be eligible for guaranteed admission:

1. Minimum GPA:

- Central Washington University - 3.0 GPA
- Eastern Washington University - 3.0 GPA
- Evergreen State College - 2.5 GPA
- Washington State University - 3.0 GPA
- Western Washington University – 3.0 GPA
- Pacific Lutheran University - 3.3 GPA
- St. Martin's University - 3.0 GPA

1. Students who meet the criteria will receive an admissions letter from the college admissions offices during their senior year.
